2.a Village Park Update

Brindley will solicit alternative dumping locations for village contractors.

Gerber Leisure Products will provide the committee with estimates for receptacles, a message board, and benches to be potentially placed throughout the village.

The park dumpster and Advancement can collection will be moved to the side area off Hughitt Street near the village park. The Advancement will provide material estimates to the board and/or committee.

2.b Farm Market

Farmers Market Manager A Chitwood will reach out to Spudmobile and Ridgeway Lumber to review possibilities. Chitwood will schedule Jose's Taco Truck for a couple Sundays at the Farmer's Market after the water tower project completion.

Village Staff will provide the Farm Market a schedule of road construction when it is available.
